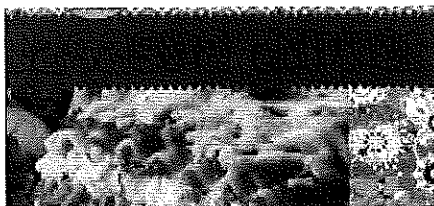

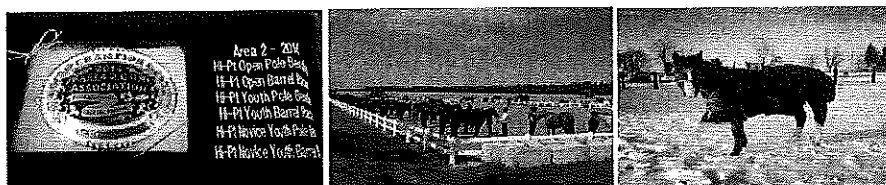

**Horse I will be showing this year:** I am not going to be showing this year, but will continue taking lessons on Oliver!

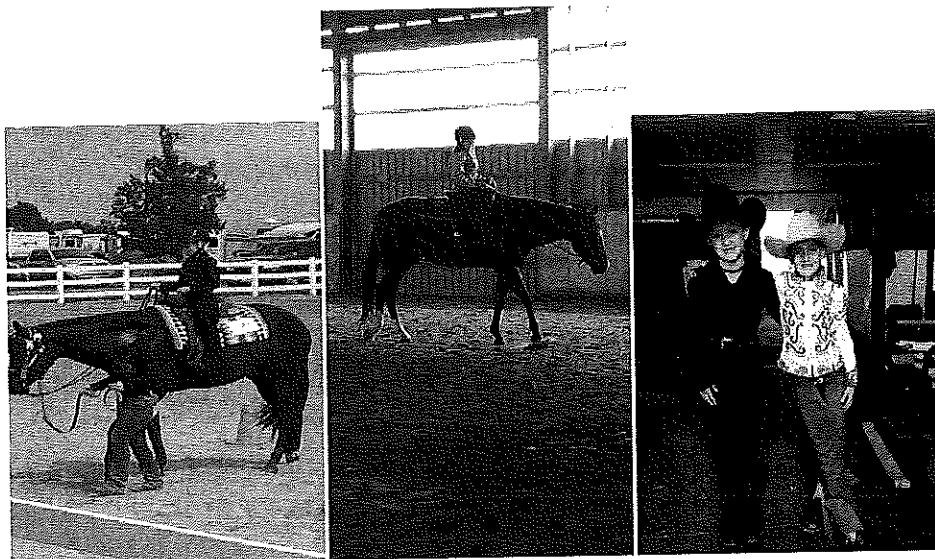
**What is your greatest accomplishment so far?** My greatest accomplishment was winning the lead line circuit award at Summerama last year.

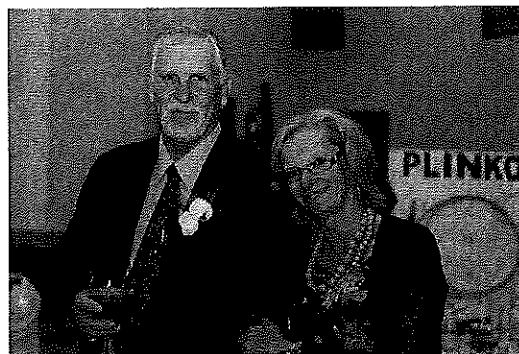

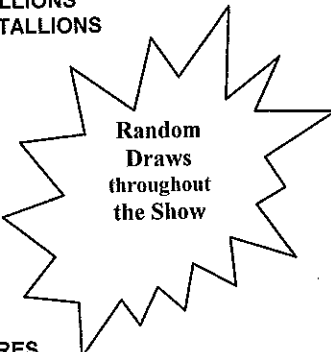

## AQHA LEVELING

For Rookie eligibility, both the Horse and the Exhibitor need to be  
Rookie, meaning as a team you cannot have more than 10 Lifetime  
points in that class. Example: Joe Exhibitor has 5 Showmanship  
points and Horse has 3 Showmanship points which equals 8 points  
total then this means that the team is eligible for the Rookie  
Showmanship class.

ELIGIBILITY: As per AQHA Rule SHW130 it is the show secretary's  
responsibility to verify exhibitor eligibility. When an Exhibitor and  
Horse enter Rookie, Level 1 or Level 2 in any division, the exhibitor  
needs to supply a copy of their levelling eligibility to the show  
secretary. Exhibitors are encouraged to verify their eligibility by going  
to [www.aqha.com/findyourlevel](http://www.aqha.com/findyourlevel) and print off their proof of eligibility.  
Beginning January 2016, if an exhibitor does not provide their proof of  
eligibility, they will be allowed to only enter Level 3.

## New Rules for 2015

To enter the Green (L1) Open, Novice (L1) and Rookie Youth/Amateur  
classes, you must show your eligibility sheet printed from the AQHA  
Website.

As of January 1, 2015 all youth (18 & under) at all AQHA-sanctioned  
events, when riding in an English hunt saddle, just wear properly  
fastened protective headgear that meets ASTM/SEI standards or  
equivalent international standards for equestrian use. The helmet  
must also be properly fitted with harness secured.
